I have to-day had the visit of Dr. Mogens CHRISTIANSEN and Dr. Sv. B. ASTRUP. Both of these doctors are from FIN and have been active collaborators in the Tjable Organisation. Dr. ASTRUP has been here for some time but Dr. CHRISTIANSEN is a recent arrival, and prior to his departure he met NINT and LEEK.

2. Dr. ASTRUP and Dr. CHRISTIANSEN came to this office with a request that we should support them in their endeavours to have CARROT sent to a hospital for treatment for his stomach trouble. Dr. CHRISTIANSEN, who attended CARROT in Denmark, states that CARROT is a pathological drunkard and that his present stomach trouble has been exaggerated by his alcoholic excesses.

3. CARROT, as has already been reported to you in my telegram 0235 of June 9th, is drinking very heavily here and is being indiscreet. It is, therefore, essential that some decision should be made regarding his future.

4. Dr. CHRISTIANSEN tells me that he was informed by both NINT and LEEK that they knew of CARROT's excessive drinking and that it was for this reason that they decided to evacuate him and that they do not want him sent back to the Field under any circumstances.

5. I feel strongly that, if this is the case (and the circumstances certainly seem to indicate that there is a considerable amount of truth in this), then it is essential for us in Stockholm to be informed of the full facts of the case in order that we may protect the security of those Tjable boys who are now in Sweden and, particularly, of those who are still in the Field.
